



## **2020 SGMP CHAPTER BOARD “CALL FOR NOMINATIONS”**

The ROCKY MOUNTAIN Chapter of the Society of Government Meeting Professionals is looking for leaders! Nominations are now being accepted for all eight elected positions\* on the 2020-2022 ROCKY MOUNTAIN Chapter Board of Directors. The incoming chapter board shall be sworn in during the chapter meeting/event nearest to, but before, the July 1<sup>st</sup> start date of their term of office from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022. If you wish to be considered as a candidate, or wish to nominate someone else, the nomination form and information on the nominations & elections process may be found at <https://www.sgmprockymtn.com/>, under the “GET INVOLVED” tab. **The nominations period will remain open until 5:00pm local time on April 10.**

Any chapter member in good standing for at least six months (in the category noted below) prior to nomination shall qualify for nomination to and election on the chapter board of directors:

<b>President</b>	(Government Planner or Contract Planner)
<b>First Vice President</b>	(Government Planner or Contract Planner)
<b>Second Vice President</b>	(Supplier)
<b>Secretary</b>	(Government Planner or Contract Planner)
<b>Treasurer</b>	(Supplier or Contract Planner)
<b>Directors (3)*</b>	(1) Government Planner; (1) Supplier; (1) Government Planner, Contract Planner, or Supplier

\*The Chapter Director positions are eliminated from the elections process if the chapter elected to have the variance of a five-member elected board.

SGMP has made several revisions to the bylaws and policies affecting chapter elections since this chapter’s last election. This year’s timeline has also been revised. Key nominations & elections process deadlines this year are the following:

- Chapter nominations must close by 4/10/20
- Chapter membership online voting opens on 4/22/20
- Chapter membership online voting closes at 5:00pm ET on 4/28/20
- Chapter election results are announced to entire chapter by 4/30/20
- New chapter board members must be installed by 6/30/20
- Code of Ethics form (signed by all new chapter board members) must be received at SGMP by 6/30/20
